BOOK OF REMEMBRANCE

**E**very tree that is planted in memorial or in celebration of a special occasion is recorded in a Book of Remembrance in beautiful gothic, copperplate handwriting. All entries in the books are professionally inscribed by Calligraphy UK, [www.remembrancebook.co.uk](http://www.remembrancebook.co.uk).

Each entry can be viewed by the client or family representative at any time during normal office hours. However, in cases where we have the Book of Remembrance displayed in hospices and some hospitals, the entries can be viewed at almost any time. It is usual to have these books on display in the chapel areas of the appointed beneficiary for each planting location.

Arrangements have been made for every page in every full Book of remembrance, no matter where they have been displayed, to be kept in the archives department at Manchester Cathedral initially and eventually at Liverpool Cathedral and Salisbury Cathedral for those clients living in the South of England. This means that generation on generation will be able to trace back the family tree, the species of tree planted, the date of the planting and the special plot number which has been allocated.
